Both Howie & Martin presented the New 50th Anniversary Kennedy Four Half Dollar Sets, minted in 90% Silver from the 1964 High Relief Design. The set includes, 1 Proof Mint Mark P, 1 Reverse Proof Mint Mark W, 1 Enhanced Uncirculated Mint Mark S, Uncirculated Mint Mark D. An Impressive Set..

Evans had 2 two 1oz. Canadian Maple Leaf Coins, a 1999 and a 2014. The 2014 has a privy mark on the reverse.

Neal shared two items; a press release announcing that the U.S. Mint will release a March of Dimes Coin. The silver \$1 Commemorative will be released in 2015. The second item, an article about Roman Empire (EAST) 25,000 Denier hoard found in Great Britain. He also showed a 1 gram gold Maple leaf, one of the smallest coins made.
